The Federation of Registered Safety Auditors

After the successful Safety Auditors Conference in October 2004, auditors' associations agreed to consider the development of a self-regulated body tentatively named "The Federation of Registered Safety Auditors". The objectives of the Federation are to foster the profession of safety auditing in Hong Kong.

A draft Memorandum and Articles of Federation is being prepared for discussion amongst the representatives of the Safety Auditors' Associations. It is proposed that the Executive Committees of the Federation will be representatives of the member associations and individual RSA. The Federation will hold regular meetings, represent the common interest of the RSA, organize conferences and seminars. It is also the intention to develop, implement, operate and maintain a Safety Auditing Certification Scheme (SACS). The SACS is aimed at setting an audit standard for safety auditing in Hong Kong. Also, Scheme participants will be entitled to use Certified Registered Safety Auditor (CRSA) to represent their professional status.

Reporting Writing skills for Safety Auditors

SASA is pleased to announce that a training course in the "Reporting Writing Skills for Safety Auditors" in collaboration with the Hong Kong Polytechnic University will be held in early March 2005. The course will be held every Wednesday from 6:30 to 9:30 p.m and last for 7 weeks.

The proposed course fee is HK\$2,8000 per person and the anticipated class size is around 20. Certificate of attainment will be awarded by the Hong Kong Polytechnic University to those participants who have successfully completed the training course and satisfy the assessment.

Hong Kong Polytechnic University will prepare pamphlet with information for distribution in due course.
