Annual Conference of Safety Auditors

The safety auditor conference will be held on 29th Oct 2005 at Miramar Hotel jointly organized by SASA, HKRSAA and HKSOSA. SASA anticipated allowing 200-300 participants to joint the conference.

There are 4 keynote speakers :

1. Mr. Pang Kwok Lam, Chief Occupational Safety Officer (Operation), Topic :

The Enforcement Phase of the Factories and Industrial Undertakings (Safety Management) Regulations.

2. Ms. Martha Mc Dougall, San Diego and a consultant to college and universities in EHS programmes, Topic :

Practical Approach of Safety Management Audit for Tertiary Education Institutions.

3. Dr. Y.Y. Wong, president of SASA, Topic :

Introduction to SHARE Scheme. A program for Achieving Excellence in Safety Management Audits in Hong Kong.

4. Mr. Chris C.Y. Tsang, Solicitor, Topic :

The Liabilities and Legal Obligation of a Safety Auditor.

Reporting Writing skills for Safety Auditors

The 1st intake of the Reporting writing skill for safety auditors is completed. Feedback are being collected to review the course. SASA planned to enhance the course content by adding more lecturers expertised in different area to report writing skills. The 2nd intake is anticipated to be started in December 2005.

The Occupational Safety and Health Council has granted 18 CPD points under the ISAS scheme for students who have completed this CEF approved course.
