## **THE 7<sup>TH</sup> MAINLAND CHINA, TAIWAN, HONG KONG AND MACAU OSH CONFERENCE** **APOSHO 15 (15<sup>TH</sup> ASIA PACIFIC OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY & HEALTH CONFERENCE)**

This annual conference will be held in Macau from 20-23<sup>rd</sup> October 1999. The APOSHO15 annual conference will be held in Manila, Philippines from 28-30 October 1999. Both functions were accepted by OSHC as a CPD credit course last year. Interest member can seek information from the Secretariat.

## **F & IU (SAFETY MANAGEMENT) BILL**

Following our presentation to the Bill's Committee on the proposed F&IU (Safety management) Bill, the Authority has sent in their responses which were quite disappointing. None of our suggestions, as well as suggestions by the other 13 organizations making presentations were accepted.

We have written further to the Bill's Committee and also attended their meeting as observer on 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1999.

There were a lot of opinion and questions by the members of the committee on the newly proposed legislation. It was emphasized that the SM Regulation was only tabled as information to show what the Commissioner for Labour would make if he

were given the authority under the F&IU (Amendment) Bill 1999. The Legislative Council would have full and positive scrutiny of the Regulation when it is officially tabled. The general consensus was that full discussion and debate on the SM Regulation could be postponed when it is tabled and would concentrate on the F&IU(Amendment) Bill 1999.

The public would have more chances to comment on this very important legislation affecting the auditing profession later.

## **CODE OF ETHICS**

The code of ethics was finalised and will be laminated and posted in the EOSS Centre of HKPU. Member will receive a copy in due course.
